School Uniform

- Grey Trousers or Shorts and Navy Blue Skirt or Pinafore
- Pale Blue Polo Shirt
- Navy School Sweatshirt or Cardigan with School Logo
- Dark Socks or Tights
- Black School Shoes *black trainers, boots or high heeled shoes do not conform to school uniform rules
- Navy Blue Checked School Dress in the Summer with Dark Socks

PE Kit

- Navy Shorts (Navy Joggers may be worn in Winter)
- White Polo Shirt
- Black Daps or Dark Trainers

Forest School Gear

- Wellies

Pupil Appearance:

- A single stud or pair of studs can be worn – no hoops or earrings
- Make up or nail varnish is not permitted
- Haircuts should be appropriate for school and long hair must be tied up for safety reasons.
